

RESTOR-A-FLOOR

SPRAY BUFF FOR HIGH- & ULTRA-SPEED BUFFING

DESCRIPTION:

RESTOR-a-FLOOR is a unique formulation that imparts floor-restoring qualities formerly not available in conventional spray-buff systems.

Outstanding features of RESTOR-a-FLOOR:

- Restores Original Gloss To Floors
- Removes Black Heel Marks
- Removes Scuff Marks
- Dissolves Oil And Water Soluble Soils
- Does Not Impair Slip Resistance
- Retards Powdering

APPEARANCE:

White viscous emulsion with mild scent.

FOR USE ON:

RESTOR-a-FLOOR can be used on all types of resilient and non-resilient flooring.

DIRECTIONS:

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING!

Spray RESTOR-a-FLOOR over an area of approximately 50 square feet. Spray lightly; a little goes a long way. Spray a small amount directly onto black heel marks. While the floor is still wet, run a rotary floor machine (with a suitable spray-buff pad) over the entire area. Heel machine over black marks.

The first pass will remove all dirt, scuff, and black heel marks. A second pass with the machine will result in a brilliant shine. Turn pad over periodically to reduce build-up. RESTOR-a-FLOOR can be diluted 50% with water if black heel marks are not a problem.

RESTOR-a-FLOOR may also be used for light scrubbing with an automatic machine or for normal damp mopping. Just dilute 6 oz. RESTOR-a-FLOOR in gallon of water; then, damp mop or lightly scrub floor. Floor may then be buffed while it is dry or still wet. A high-speed buffer will greatly enhance the qualities obtained with RESTOR-a-FLOOR.
